- Bill Lovel: news from JFK, organisational changes (JFK)
 - BL and KL retired, school sold to group of parents, JFK now non-profit organisation, KE new AD at JFK, continued commitment to SGIS sports (skiing and swimming). Bill presented new programme: Lovel Camps = summer and winter programmes for competitive and freestyle skiing, as well as snowboarding

- 4. Tournament preview (ISZL)
 - Information from each host school on:

 - HE presented a new format to enter information into the calendar, all SGIS tournaments for 2011-12 have been reviewed, information was given by each host AD and entered into the spreadsheet (see attached). Non-attendant ADs must send information to HE to be entered into the calendar
 - Volleyball Cat B boys tournament is not needed, Cat B boys can play up in Cat A tournament, schools may ask EH if second team allowed in the Leysin tournament
 - o Indoor Football Cat C girls at Basel is cancelled, due to low participation
 - o Basketball Cat A girls at Aiglon only one day, Saturday 12 November
 - Unihockey Cat C boys & girls at ISL changed to Cat B, due to low interest for Cat C
 - Indoor Football Cat D boys at Nations changed to Friday 25 November
 - Swimming Cat A-D at Basel, Saturday 21 January, also includes Category D
 - Skiing Giant Slalom Cat A+B (SGIS) / C+D (Invitational) at Aiglon changed to Sunday 22 January
 - Skiing Giant Slalom Cat B-C-D by Haut Lac at Morgins changed to Tuesday 31 January
 - Volleyball Cat A boys at LGB, one day only, Saturday 28 January, and changed to be Invitational
 - Badminton Cat C-E boys and girls by Haut Lac in Lausanne changed to Friday 9 March
 - Basketball Cat D boys at ISL changed to Saturday 10 March
 - Volleyball Cat A girls at Brillamont, Sat-Sun 17-18 March, changed to be Invitational
 - Football regional Cat F regional at St Georges changed to Wednesday

 - Football regional Cat D at St Georges, we keep a spring championship on Thursday 31 May, as well as the fall championships hosted by St Georges and ISL on Saturdays 1 and 8 Oct

- 5. CAT B girls volleyball: who can pick it up? (ICSZ)
 - ISB considers hosting this tournament (see attached calendar), instead
 of the Cat C girls indoor soccer tournament. This will not take place due
 to poor participation. MW to confirm.
- 6. Invitational preview (ISZL)

 - Gymnastics Cat C-F at St Georges, May/June TBC, new gymnastic coach, info to come

7. Sports Committee (ISZL)

- Current members
 - HE, MW, EO, EH, PM, +1. One position vacant. Need geographical spread, someone from the Geneva area. Patrick to host December meeting.
- Open position
 - Ethan volunteered to join the committee, all ADs in support, welcome to the committee!
- Points for the December SGIS Sports Committee meeting:
 - MT points out that he interest in rugby calls for an annual SGIS championship. Committee to develop a handbook proposal to be presented to the SGIS executive. SP suggests integration into rugby federation to be considered.
 - AC reminds group that each school has an obligation to host a tournament. Committee to check the status quo and inform at the next AGM: who hosts..., who participates... AC suggests that small schools can fulfil their obligation as a co-host.
 - MT asks for clarification of rule: players to play up by the discretion of the AD. This cannot happen in different tournaments on the same day. Playing-up athlete must stay in the higher category for the whole tournament. Committee to prepare a more clear definition to be included into the handbook at the next AGM.
 - OPM reports that his director is very concert about safety when younger students are allowed to play up. DS is in support of having the option to play an athlete up, as it allows Berne to field teams in some tournaments where their numbers are low. Clarification that this is to the discretion of the AD, and only if the player is physical strong enough. It should not be considered solely for the reason of entering a team. It is only allowed to bring up a player to the next higher category, not two categories up. It is the ADs responsibility to assure that a younger athlete does not take a place of an athlete in the correct age category. Committee to clarify guidelines.
